

WRO SA WeDo 2.0 2018

"This needs to be a fun, confidence building and learning experience"

As this is a pilot challenge the format and rules have been left wide open.

WRO SA has decided on the following format for the WeDo challenge 2018

Guidelines:

- WeDo will only happen at provincial level.
- All participants will receive a participation certificate and an award Teams will be banded into reaching 3 scoring levels
- All teams reaching a certain score will receive the Bronze award
- All teams reaching the next score level will receive the Silver award
- All teams reaching the highest scoring band will receive the Gold award
- The WeDo challenge in Gauteng will run for 2 hrs. 30 mins same as Explorer on a Friday afternoon
- 60 mins practice/testing and then 90 mins to register scores
- (No limit on scoring runs)
- Highest registered score to count
- 2-3 learners per team (2 recommended)
- Arrive with a pre-built robot
- Re-program the solution on the day Please delete all other programs on tablet/PC
- Only WeDo code to be used
- Tablets allowed around competition table manage crowding with definite holding line for next team in line.
- "Emphasis on fun and a relaxed atmosphere"
